



## Financial Agreement

### Registration

- An annual, non-refundable registration fee of \$75 per student is due at the time of registration which is payable by all students including scholarship recipients.
- An annual, non-refundable production fee of \$200 per student is due at the time of registration. The production fee is optional, and is for Beginning Pre-Ballet through Level III/IV students that would like to participate in performances throughout the school year. Families must determine whether or not their child will participate in performances at the time of registration. NO changes will be permitted at any point during the school year. If you elect to participate in performances during the 2017-2018 school year the production fee is due at the time of registration.
- I understand that any scholarship received from the BAA is subject to all rules and regulations that I have read in the BAA handbook and I agree to all rules and regulations in the handbook. If the scholarship is revoked for any reason by the BAA, I agree to pay the full amount of tuition and fees immediately. I also understand that all scholarship students must attend all rehearsal, perform in all BAA performances and outreach programs.

### Tuition

The following tuition rates apply for 1 full Ballet Arts Academy Season. (Tuition will be divided into ten payments with the exception of Open Classes which are due in full at registration.)

- All accounts that are 30 days past due will be referred to an outside collection agency.
- Any student whose tuition account is not paid up to date 2 weeks prior to any performance will not be allowed to perform regardless of payment of production fee.
- Acceptable payment methods are cash, check, and credit card. All checks should be made payable to Ballet Arts Academy. A \$35 returned check fee will be assessed if a check is returned for any reason. If a check is returned, all future payments must be made by cash, cashier's check, or credit card.
- Class commitments are for the entire school year (except open classes). Therefore, each family will be responsible for the entire year's tuition listed above regardless of class attendance or participation. Also, no refunds will be issued for early withdrawal from Ballet Arts Academy.
